The Peptide Buzz—And What You Should Know

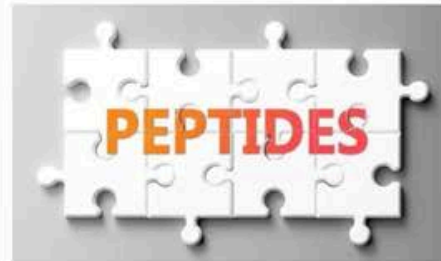
Peptides are everywhere right now – promising more energy, better muscle tone, glowing skin, deeper sleep and more.
