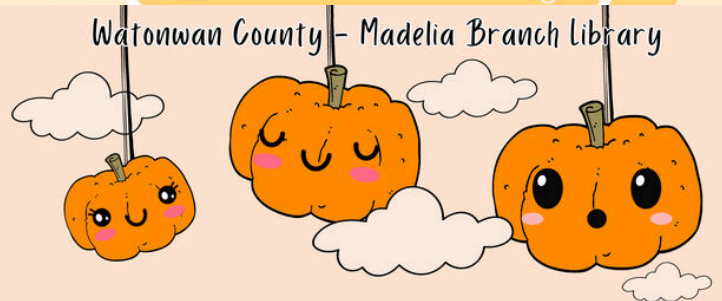

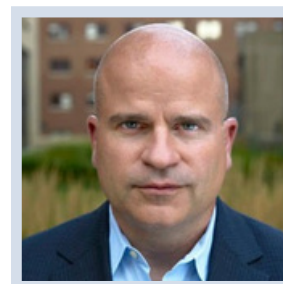

The National Telecommunications Alliance (NTCA) is The Rural Broadband Association. The website states, "NTCA helps members build and deliver broadband connectivity and operate essential services in rural and small-town communities across the U.S."

Fiber Broadband is "... the infrastructure challenge of this generation. ... In 2024, you can't fully participate in your life, you're not going to be able to do school, you're not going to be able to get your healthcare right. You're not going to be able to have the same economic opportunities if you don't have rural broadband. That is not just the future. That is the present." - Senator Amy Klobuchar.

NTCA created the federally recognized Smart Rural Community (SRC) network and certification. Internet service providers partner with NTCA which upgrades the internet provider's connection to broadband to strengthen digital connections within and outside the community. This partnership is the certification.

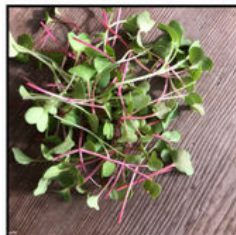

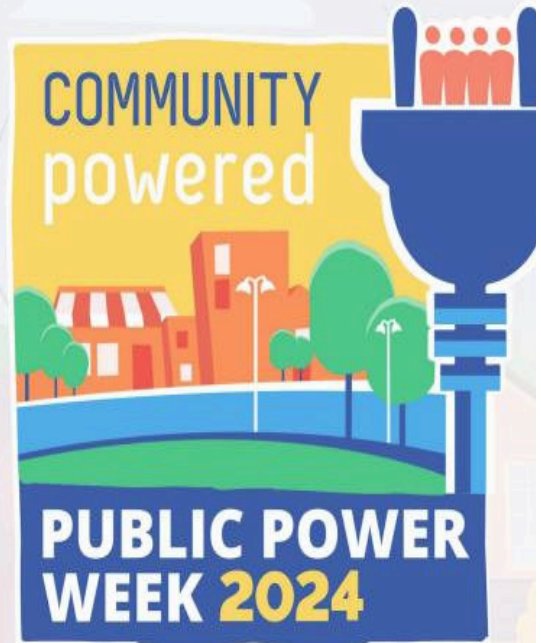

To mark Public Power Week, MMLP offers a few tips on how to save energy and money in your home as we build for the future:

- According to the Alliance to Save Energy, the average U.S. home uses 70 light bulbs. Even though modern bulbs are energy efficient, you should still turn them off when they aren't in use.
- Swap out old incandescent bulbs for new LED bulbs. According to the Department of Energy, residential LEDs -- especially ENERGY STAR-rated products -- use at least 75% less energy, and last up to 25 times longer, than incandescent lighting
- Heating and cooling your home uses a lot of energy. Set your thermostat lower in the winter and higher in the summer to save energy and money on your power bill.
- Unplug appliances when you aren't using them. Even when they aren't being used, they are sometimes drawing "phantom power," which wastes energy.
- Your home's water heater is a big energy user. Make sure to use cold water when you can and turn off the hot water while you are scrubbing your hands.
- Consider asking your utility about a home energy audit. Energy efficiency experts can use special equipment to find things around your home—like air leaks—that may be costing you energy and money.

"Helping Madelia residents lower their monthly electric bills by using energy wisely is a top priority for us," said Chris Trembley, General Manager. "While we continue to invest in building a resilient and future-ready utility, we also encourage our customers to play their part in conserving energy.
