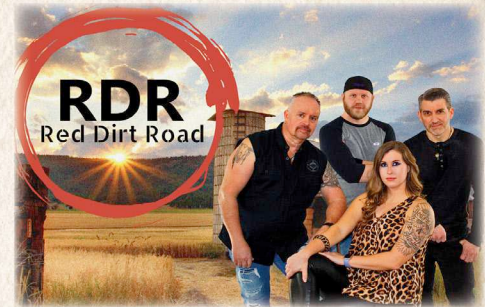

2022 Health Care Scholarships

Madelia Health Foundation Health Care Scholarships
